### FALL 2018 WEBCAST "Advancing U.S. Coal Exports"

### **SUMMARY OF MEETING**

October 1, 2018

The National Coal Council convened a webcast/meeting at 11:32 a.m. ET. This meeting was presented online via WebEx.

### Welcome

Joe Giove provided the welcome address and opening remarks to the group. ASFE Steve Winberg was not present for this meeting.

### **Call to Order and Anti-Trust Advisory**

Joe Giove mentioned there will be an opportunity for NCC members to ask questions.

Joe Giove also mentioned the goal of this meeting is to discuss and conduct a vote to finalize the draft of the reports that NCC has been working on for the past several months.

The previous meeting was cancelled due to the path of Hurricane Florence, and evacuation requirements.

Joe Giove called on NCC legal counsel, Eric Hutchins, for an Anti-Trust Advisory reading.

Joe Giove iterated this meeting is being held in compliance with FACA regulations, and a recording of the meeting will be posted to the FACA database following the meeting.

Joe reported that based on attendance, there is a quorum for this meeting. A poll to publish the report will take place at the end of the meeting where active NCC members can vote.

There will be time for a public comment period at the end of the meeting.

Joe Giove noted he received no requests ahead of the September 26, 2018, deadline, and no requests for verbal comments ahead of the deadline.

# PowerPoint Presentation of "Advancing U.S. Coal Exports" Report

Joe Giove introduced David Lawson and Justin Burk to present the report.

After the presentation, we will conduct a vote on whether to finalize the report.

NCC members can post questions using the chat feature, only NCC members are authorized to ask questions.

Justin Burk thanked NCC members and people attending the call for their time, and presented his slides.

David Lawson begins presenting on slide 7 of the same PowerPoint.

Conclusion of PowerPoint and turns back over to Janet Gellici and Joe Giove.

Joe Giove opened the Q&A session for NCC members, giving instruction on the chat feature in WebEx. Offers "raise hand" feature for those who can't figure out the chat feature.

Joe Giove mentioned the presentation was clear and skillfully presented, and because there are no questions, they will now move onto a vote for the final report.

Joe Giove turns over to Tech Support to handle the polling function, and explains how to access and use the polling function.

NCC members can vote 1 of 3 options: to agree, not agree, or abstain voting.

Barbara Altizer and David Lawson expressed issues with trying to access the poll.

Issue is resolved, and all participants can see the poll.

Jackie Bird states she was unable to log onto the WebEx and will sent her affirmative vote to Janet Gellici via email so she has a positive record of her vote.

Joe Giove notes that polling is now closed and thanks members.

Joe Giove mentions that the group will now switch to the second report.

Janet Gellici mentions that they will work on a tabulation of the votes to ensure NCC members were voting and will let the group know of the results.

# Presentation of "Power Reset: Optimizing the Existing U.S. Coal Fleet to Ensure a Reliable & Resilient Power Grid" Report

Janet Gellici thanked everyone for their patience.
